# Splice Instruction

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### **EMERGENCY SPLICE INSTRUCTIONS**

• Step 1: Count 30 right hand strands and mark the rope after the 30iest strand. See photo 1.

• Step 2: Form the rope to the desired eye length and mark the eye. See photo 2.



• Step 3: Undo the 12 strands at the end and wrap them firmly in adhesive tape. See photo 3A and 3B.

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• Step 4: As from the marked sign (see small white rope on photo 4) you mark two tucks. On photo 4 the left hand strands are marked red and the right hand strands are marked green.

Undo the strands until you have two left hand strands and two right hand strands.

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• **Step 5:** Remove the two right hand strands which are closest to the marked part (small white rope) and tape them to each other. See photo 6.

• Then take clockwise the next two strands, which are on photo 7 the left hand strands marked in red.

 Next take the two right hand strands (marked red) and continue with the two left hand strands (marked green) until all right hand and left hand strands are taped in series of two strands.



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• Step 6: the first tuck. Put the first 2 right hand strands (green) under the eye. See photo 9A. Next tuck the nearest by two left hand strands (red) in the rope under the left hand strands. See photo 9B.



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• The second tuck. After the first tuck you take clockwise the right hand strand (green) and tuck them as shown on photo 10.

• Carefully pull the strands. See photo 11.

• The third tuck. Again take clockwise two right hand strands and tuck them in the rope as shown on photo 12.

• The fourth tuck. Half turn the eye and tuck two left hand strands (red) in the rope. See photo 13A and 13B.

• The fifth tuck. Take two right hand strands (green) and tuck them in the rope as shown on photo 14A and 14B.



The sixth tuck. Take the final two left hand strands (red) and tuck them in the rope as shown in photo 15A and 15B.

When all strands are in the right position carefully pull the strands in such a way that all marks are close to each other and form one whole. See photo 16.

• Step 7: Now tuck all strands per series of two left hand and two right hand strands over one strand and under two strands as shown on photo 17A and 17B (left under left and right under right).

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• Do this step "over 1 strand, under 2 strands" 10x. See photo 18A and 18B.

• When the strands are tucked then 10x unwrap the strands and tuck them away in the rope one strand over two strands (upper strands). See photo 19.


